Your student may have an opportunity to participate in the California Junior Scholarship Federation (CJSF), grades 7 and 8. This organization was designed to acknowledge and promote students achieving academically at a high level. I would like to take a few moments to explain the rules and regulations for qualification to CJSF. Please review the following guidelines to determine whether your student qualifies for this honorable distinction:

CJSF qualification

A student must reapply each semester.

All grades earned the previous semester must be the equivalent of C or better.

A grade of D or F automatically disqualifies for that semester.

If you believe that your student qualifies for CJSF please review the course list and fill out the application which can be found attached to this document or at www.guajome.net/guidance. The deadline for fall 2006 submission of application is February 2, 2007. Please return to Kay Preston in the guidance department.

To qualify for CJSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

1. You must earn TWICE the number of points than courses in which you are enrolled that meet membership requirements.
2. No points are earned for P.E., a remedial or repeated course, or work experience in which pay is involved.
3. CJSF points are granted as follows:
A = 3 points
B = 1 points
C = 0 points

One additional point shall be granted for a grade of "A" or "B" in an Honors course, up to a maximum of two such points per semester.

D/F = Will debar from membership if received in ANY class.

1. Semester membership is based on work done in the previous semester.
2. You must reapply each semester for membership.
