**APPROVAL OF AGENDA/MINUTES**

Agenda was approved with addition of Boosters request for athletic banners. Minutes were approved.

**FINANCIAL REPORT**

The current balance is \$19,972.57. Kathryn gave an overview of the working budget and some standard expenses such as 8<sup>th</sup> grade lock in and HS graduation were discussed.

**TEACHER REPORT**

Cindy Jorstad sent a message through Tammy thanking FOF for the contribution to the orchestra and choir uniforms and inviting all FOF to the concert tonight in the gym.

A request was made from the middle school teachers for a donation to the 2000 readers party – MS students who read a total of 2000 pages by a certain date would get a party. Discussion was held and it was moved and approved to donate \$200.

A request was made for a donation for the “question of the day” trivia game that is announced each morning with the daily announcements – students who get the right answer could receive a restaurant gift card. Discussion was held and it was moved and approved to donate \$200.

**REQUEST FROM BOOSTERS FOR CONTRIBUTION TO ATHLETIC BANNERS**

Chris Findell followed up on last month’s meeting with two proposals – 1 to obtain banners for the 5 sports which GPA has already received CIF

recognition, and another for all 11 sports in which GPA students participate. Discussion was held and it was moved and approved to donate \$500 to Boosters towards the 5 banners, and to loan Boosters the additional \$566 needed to purchase the 5 banners.

### **HALLOWEEN DANCE RECAP**

A debrief of the Halloween dance was held. Positives were: having chairpeople for different tasks, ie, gate, dj, hallway, tickets, food; hallway was terrific; entrance was much quicker and smoother than last year – having the last name alphabet tables worked well, but there was a comment that the lists should be more organized. Sold out of candy, buy more next time. Have a separate area of drinks for the volunteers so they don't keep going to kitchen and taking drinks that we intend to sell. Pot luck chair for next time would be helpful. Kids & parents didn't like the "searches" at the door, if that is going to be GPA policy, then GPA staff should conduct the searches, not FOFers. The DJ was expensive, not fantastic and not willing to bargain. Presales went well but it was observed that next time don't sell during advisory or after school, lunchtime worked best. Separate signups in advance for volunteers next year would help organize the helpers better.

### **FEBRUARY DANCE DJ**

It was agreed to research a new DJ for the February dance – Tammy has some options.

### **CAMPBELL SOUP LABELS**

A request was made for a volunteer to coordinate the collection of Campbells soup labels as another means of revenue for FOF. A suggestion was made to have Builder's Club do it – Tammy will present the idea to them.

### **REQUESTS TABLED FROM OCTOBER**

It was decided to discuss the amount of FOF scholarships after the first of the year. Rich reminded the group that it had moved and approved a \$450 donation to teacher incentives (Blue Ticket Buffet).
